Descriptions of Ministry Opportunities

To help you with your discernment of where you may wish to be involved in our ministry together at ELC here are some more detailed descriptions of the opportunities listed on the preceding pages.

Worship Assistants

Communion Servers assist during worship by serving the bread and/or wine during Holy Communion which is celebrated on the 1^{st} and 3^{rd} Sundays of each month.

Greeters are often the first people that members and visitors see on Sunday mornings. They provide a warm welcome at the entrances to the church.

Readers typically read aloud two to three scripture readings during the worship service.

Audio Visual Assistants help our technology team with sound and projection during worship.

Ushers assist throughout the entire worship service beginning with handing out bulletins, directing people to their seats, helping with the offering, and other tasks before and after each worship service.

Bread Bakers provide loaves of bread once a month to be used for communion.

Our **Altar Guild** provide for the set-up and maintenance of our worship space including the paraments/banners, decorations, set-up for and clean-up of communion, etc.

For our little one's we offer **Activity Bags for Children** that include activities and supplies to keep them engaged during worship. We rely on volunteers to help maintain the bags.

Worship & Music Ministry

The **Worship & Music Ministry Team** meets monthly on the 3rd Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. to discuss upcoming worship plans, schedules, special events, etc. The team supports the musicians, music staff, and pastor(s).

ELC has a long tradition of musical talent including many opportunities for people to share their talents with the congregation and community:

> Our **Senior Choir** is open to all who love to sing. Rehearsals take place Sunday mornings from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and the choir typically sing

an anthem during the 8:30 a.m. Sunday worship during the school year and during other special services.

The **Praise Team** leads our 10:30 a.m. Sunday contemporary worship. Rehearsals take place Sunday mornings from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and include vocalists, guitar, piano, percussion, and more.

We are proud to offer a opportunity for youth to share their musical talents through our **Junior Choir**. The choir rehearses on select Wednesday evenings during the school year and shares the songs they learn with the congregation throughout the year in worship.

The **Bell Choir** rehearses on Tuesday evenings and play during worship several times during the school year. *Note: The Bell Choir will begin rehearsals in September, 2019.

Throughout the year, and especially during the summer, we love to have people share their musical talents during worship either through **Special Music** and/or by providing **Instrumental Music** at various times.

The Worship & Music Ministry Team relies on volunteers and is always looking for individuals willing to **coordinate** our worship assistants, ushers, and coordinating volunteers for special worship services throughout the year.

Small Group Ministry

ELC provides many opportunities to be involved in the life of the congregation outside of Sunday mornings. We offer a Men's Bible Study along with several Women's small groups called "Circles" which also include a quilting & sewing circle that meets at church every Thursday. Our Women of ELC (W/ELC) group also strives to mobilize women to act boldly on their faith in Jesus Christ.

Hospitality

Working in tandem with our W/ELC volunteers are needed throughout the year to help with funeral luncheons and other special events where food is served. Both of these vital ministries rely on volunteers being "oncall" to help when called upon based on a rotational schedule.

Office Help

At various times throughout the year (either on a regular or one-time basis) the church office relies on volunteers to help with various tasks. Training is always provided.

Ministry Teams

Our congregation functions via a team based ministry model where members of the congregation can serve on a ministry team that allows them to use their gifts in a way that supports the ongoing mission of the congregation. These ministry teams typically meet monthly and are always open to welcoming new members who share an interest or passion for that ministry.

By indicating your willingness to serve or your desire to learn more, a leadership member of that team will contact you to discuss your interest further and make sure that you are comfortable with meeting times, etc.

On behalf of ELC's church council, thank you for taking the time to discern where you might be able and willing to participate in the life of the congregation. We will be compiling everyone's responses and someone will follow-up with you and your family (if applicable) by the end of May. <u>If you have</u> <u>any questions, at any time, please don't hesitate to reach out to any member of the church council.</u>
