### **Things to Know:**

Tour is a WALKING tour and takes place outside. Students/staff need to dress for weather (umbrellas, jackets, comfortable shoes they can walk a distance in).

**For the safety and benefit of all attendees, we expect chaperones to be in control of group and enforce the following rules:**

- Be respectful of tour guides and other group members by not talking when guides/actors are speaking.
- Stay with the group. Don't walk off on your own.
- Refrain from horseplay. No running, jumping on statues or fountains, jumping gates at People Mover Stations, hanging over tracks, etc.
- Be respectful of others outside tour group. Make room for them if they need to pass. Don't, however, engage in conversations with strangers or give money to those who solicit. Keep valuables such as phones, cameras, jewelry and money hidden.
- We walk through a city and pavement may be uneven, hazardous, etc. Always watch where you are going including crossing streets and be aware of your surroundings.
