Ministry, Service and Outreach efforts need your support....

As things get busier with the start of the new school year, it's time to recommit to the ministries we've been called to share here at ELC. Perhaps you've been busy or away over the past few months, but the tasks of ministry continue.

The great news is that our mortgage on the church addition is about to be paid off. But maintenance and everyday expenses do not go away, and our sharing of our resources has lagged the past few months. Our general fund has been running recurring deficits, and it's not sustainable.

Perhaps some of the funds we've given to the mortgage fund over the past eleven years could now be redirected to the general fund. Please evaluate your circumstances and recommit to supporting our congregation and its various needs in a generous way. As we prepare for our annual meeting this November, prayerfully consider how we as God's people in this place can best serve the ministries of God's Church in our day.

One area of particular concern is a shortfall of about \$200 in our benevolence support for Compassion International, needed to support our relationship with Simon from Tanzania and Ariana from Mexico. The commitment our congregation made to the February benevolence recipient is now due and has fallen short of the amount it takes to support these two children. If you are able to do so, contributing now to this cause would help these children in many ways, including providing for their education.
