Eat lunch at a park.

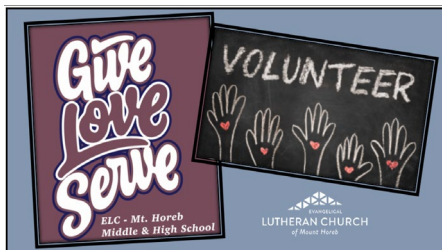
12:30 - 3:00 pm: St Vinny's Food Pantry to create boxes of food
